PROGRAM DATES: 40 weeks of instruction, beginning September and ending in June each year.

PROGRAM OVERVIEW

This program is designed to prepare students for employment as caregivers for children from birth to age 12. Emphasis is placed on fostering all areas of developments within a holistic education program.

This program combines classroom study with field placement designed to give students an opportunity to work as early childhood educators with different age groups and in a variety of child care environments.

SPECIFIC CONSIDERATIONS

In order to be successful in this field, students must enjoy working with children and fostering their cognitive, physical, social and emotional development. They should enjoy actively participating in children's activities with a high energy level and in good physical and psychological health. Other essential traits include: be organized, flexible, caring, reliable, observant and patient.

- Satisfactory immunization and medical using a standard NBCC medical form
- Satisfactory criminal record check using the Canadian Police Information Centre
- Record check consent form
- Attend a personal interview
