### **GENERAL EMERGENCY:**

Apply for Medicare Health Card: this is New Brunswick's health card used for hospital and doctors visits: click here www2.snb.ca to apply. Note that it can take up to three months to be processed and receive your card. Apply for your social insurance number, this will give you a number that you use to work in Canada. Visit: www.canada.ca to apply.

**Tele-Care 8-1-1: Call 8-1-1** any time of day or night to receive support from a nurse and get a referral to additional healthcare services in your community.

### St. Andrews

St. Andrews is a national historic site of Canada! Enjoy the beautiful ocean where you can go whale watching or take a stroll down the famous water street. It's a small town with just over 2000 people with several parks, festivals and great food!

### WHAT TO PACK:

- Required documents to present when entering Canada
- Books
- Items that remind you of your home country (eg. flag, music or family recipes)
- Medications
- Toiletries
- Weather appropriate clothes
- Light bed linens (bed sheets, pillowcases, etc)
- Laptop
- Thermometer

There's no dress code at NBCC. Students here usually dress casually in comfortable and practical clothes. Bring whatever clothing you like, in the style that you are used to wearing.

If you're in a co-op program, you'll need additional business attire for interviews and work terms.

The weather in Canada varies from season to season. Classrooms are heated in the winter and air-conditioned in the summer. However, we recommend that you bring different types of clothing to suit the changing climate outdoors.

### **CLIMATE:**

We have 4 seasons in Canada. New Brunswick is on the East coast so you get a bit more snow and cooler temperatures the more north you go.



FALL: September-December | 15 to 0 degrees Celsius



WINTER: December-May | 0 to -25 degrees Celsius



SPRING: May-June | 8 to 20 degrees Celsius



**SUMMER:** June-September | 20 to 34 degrees Celsius

**Spring and summer:** Light-weight clothing is best **Spring and fall:** Sweaters and light waterproof jackets are useful for cool and rainy days

Winter: Heavy jackets, scarves, gloves, hats and waterproof boots are essential
